In the event of a tornado **warning** with the city sirens sounding, Oak Grove Inn staff will activate our own in-house tornado alarm system to notify ALL residents of the situation. The alarm is similar to that of our Fire Alarm but interspersed with several seconds of silence. This pattern is repeated for several minutes until it's de-activated by a staff member. **All AL residents are to go into the hallway.**

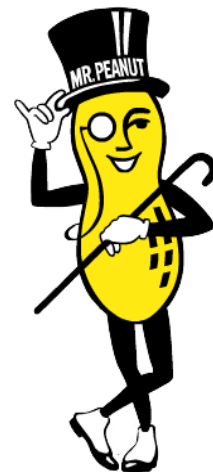
For Independent Living - you must go to the first floor to an interior hallway (not the Lobby). It is permissible to use the elevators during this time. Those who use walkers, bring them with you to sit on. It is also recommended that you **bring a pillow** to use as protection to cover your head in case of flying debris.

*** Remember, the first Wednesday of each month the City of Montgomery will sound (test) their siren system unless there is already severe weather predicted.

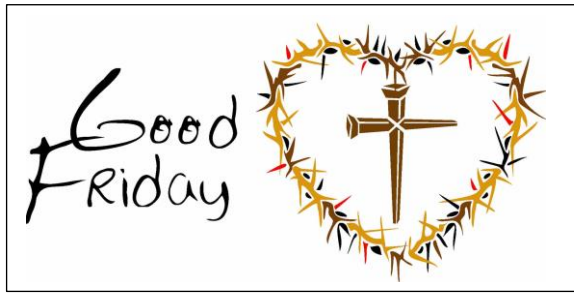
THAT OUR EASTER EGG HUNT

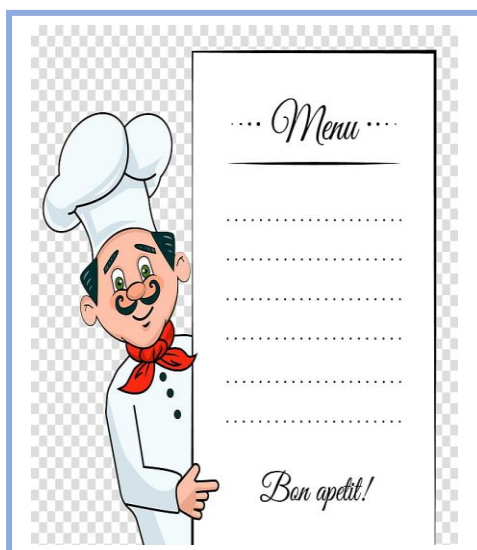
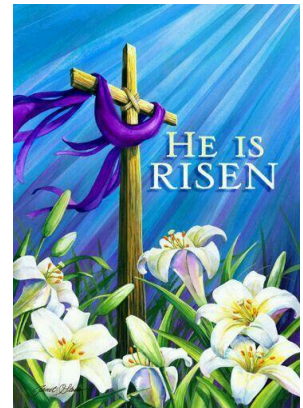


Friday, March 29th, 2024
